A Message from the State Director of Pupil Transportation

The Maryland State Department of Education's (MSDE's) Pupil Transportation End-Of-Year (EOY) Report is designed to be a visual representation of the data that Maryland's 24 Local Education Agencies (LEAs) provide to MSDE annually based on 180 school days or more transporting eligible students to and from school.

The SEED School of Maryland data is a new addition to this year's transportation report. This residential boarding school serves disadvantaged students from across the state and is based in Baltimore City. The students live in campus dormitories during the week to provide students with a uniform residential experience. To and from school transportation is provided to students on Fridays and Sundays. Since the SEED School is a publicly funded residential boarding school, it is considered an LEA for the purpose of this report.

Additionally, this year marks the first time LEA data was collected on the different fuel types of Maryland's' school buses. The purpose of collecting this information is to better understand and track over time the reduction of nonrenewable fuel types and the development of electric school vehicles being used by LEAs.

Moreover, MSDE would like to thank all of Maryland's public school transportation departments for their efforts in providing this reportable data and for their dedication to keeping student safety of paramount importance in their daily functions.

Vehicle Types Defined by the 16th National Congress on School Transportation

Conventional School Buses:

Type A: A conversion or body constructed and installed upon a van-type compact truck or front section vehicle, with a GVWR of 14,500 pounds or less, designed for carrying more than 10 persons.

Type B: A conversion or body constructed and installed upon a van or front-section chassis, or stripped chassis, with a GVWR of more than 10,000 pounds, designed for carrying more than 10 persons. Part of the engine is beneath and/or behind the windshield and beside the driver's seat. The entrance door is behind the front wheels.

Type C: A body installed upon a flat back cowl chassis with a GVWR greater than 21,500 pounds, designed for carrying more than 10 persons. The entire engine is in front of the windshield and the entrance door is behind the front wheels.

Transit Style School Buses:

Type D: A body installed upon a chassis, with the engine mounted in the front midship, or rear, with a GVWR greater than 21,500 pounds, designed for carrying more than 10 persons. The engine may be behind the windshield and beside the driver's seat; it may be at the rear of the bus behind the rear wheels, or mid-ship between the front and rear axles. The entrance door is ahead of the front wheels.

Type O (Other): Any vehicle that is not a yellow school bus or taxicab which would include a multifunction school activity bus and an alternative school vehicle used for student transportation.
